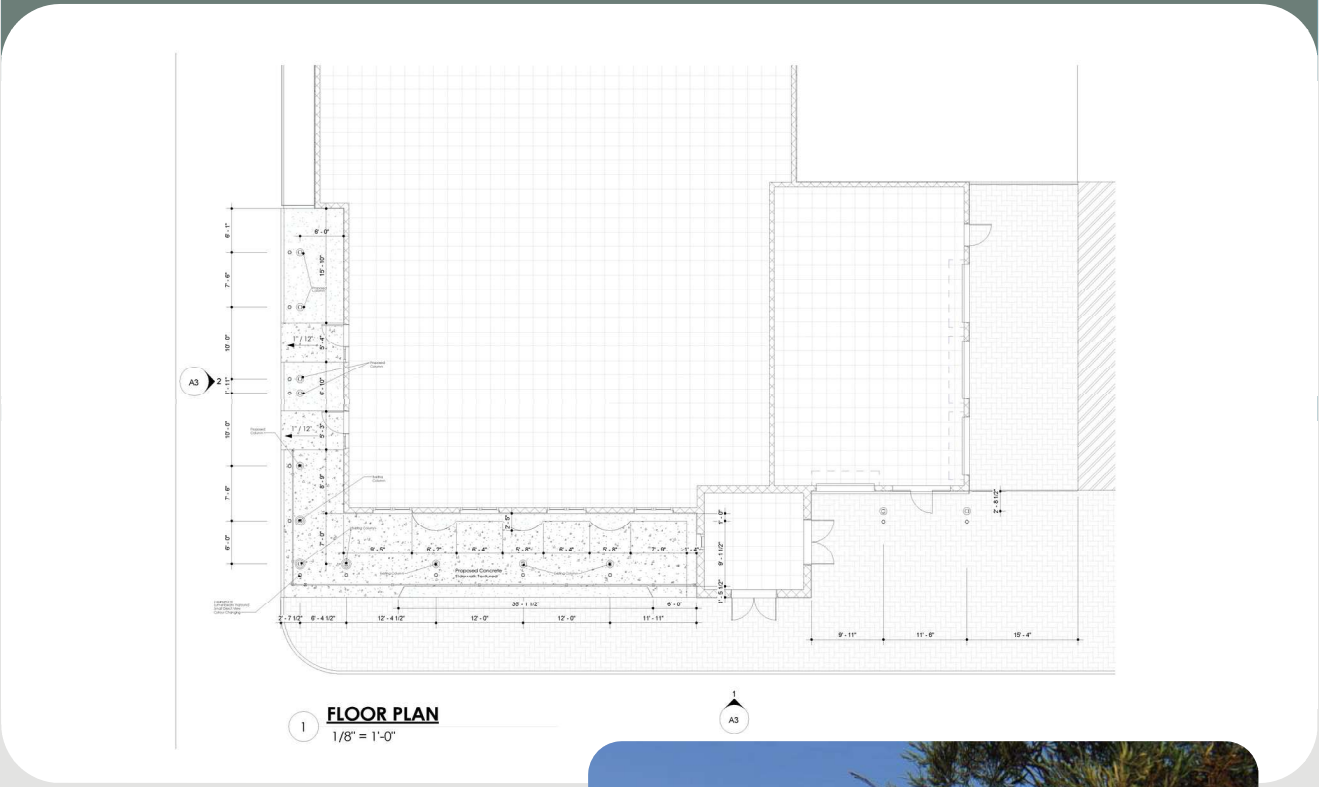

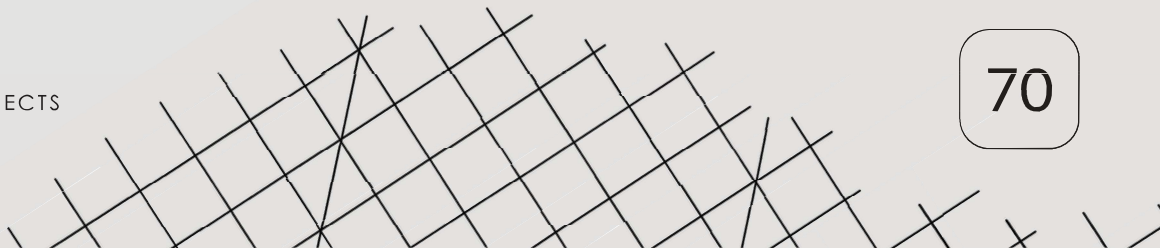
FLOOR PLAN



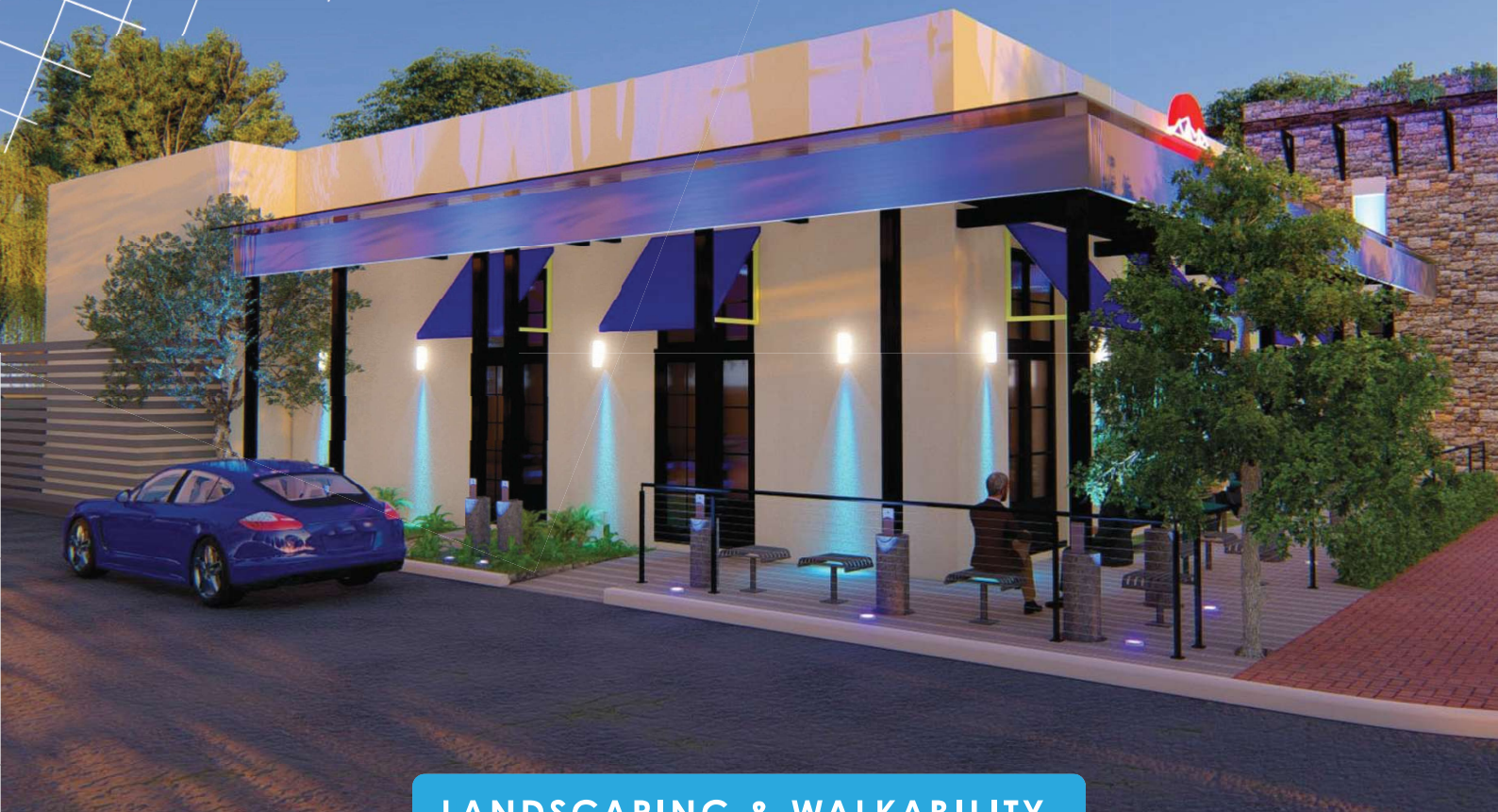
# Front Façade Setback with Hardscape Buffer
